



# **IN-PERSON SERVICES**

## **Phase 2 Guidelines**

**Under the guidelines of government officials, Harrison Faith Church will move into Phase 2 operations.** However, things are still not back to normal but we are getting closer.

While we cannot guarantee a germ-free environment, we are taking steps to help prevent transmission of Covid-19. You can read more about those steps below. **If you are sick, have a fever, present any signs of cold, flu, or COVID-19 symptoms, or if you have been in contact with anyone who has had COVID-19 in the past 14 days, please stay home.**

**We care about your health and safety. If you are in a high-risk group, we encourage you to continue attending online during Phase 2.**

As a result of social distancing guidelines, our capacity is limited to 150 people in each service. Seating availability is on a first come – first served basis until our seating capacity has been reached. If a service is full, that option will not be available.

## **Our Guidelines for Your Safety**

**Our auditorium has been set up to allow for social distancing.** We have measured and observed the federal standards – six feet between family units.

**During Phase 2, we will continue services only.** These services will include Sunday morning Adult Service, Wednesday night Prayer Service, and Wednesday night Youth Service. All other classes and activities will be online only for now.

**Childcare will be available with limited spots for those who pre-register for the appropriate age group.** The nursery and preschool will be open for the following services and ages...

Sundays starting July 12 | 8:30am & 10:30am |  
Ages birth - 4 years old

Wednesdays starting July 8 | 6:30pm |  
Ages birth - 36 months old

To better acquaint your family with the rules and guidelines for the nursery and preschool area, we ask that you please see the “Reopening Plan KidMin 2020”.

**To help prevent the spread of infection, we encourage everyone to wear a face mask when entering/exiting and while walking around the building. You are welcome to remove the face mask during the service once you are at your seat. If you forget your mask, we will be more than happy to provide you one upon request. Children ages 10 and under will not need to wear a mask. If you have a health condition that makes it impossible for you to wear a mask, we understand.**

**The Connection Center will be open starting July 12 with drinks being served by our Host Team. To assist with social distancing, we will have one-way flow through this room so we ask that you watch for the signage. We will not be promoting congregating but will have tables in the lobby to stand at while enjoying your beverages.**

**Before every service, the auditorium and all high-contact surfaces will be disinfected. We will only allow people in the building after it has been cleaned and sanitized.**

**Hand sanitizing stations are set up throughout the building. We encourage their frequent use.**

**If you need to sneeze or cough, please cover your mouth and nose or sneeze into your elbow.**

**We will continually wipe down surfaces in the restrooms and other high-contact areas.**

**Drinking fountains will not be available for use, however water is available in the Connection Center. You are encouraged to bring your favorite water bottle from home for refreshment during the service.**

**We will not distribute any bulletins or printed materials.**

Offering envelopes will be placed on the chairs. Extras will be removed and destroyed between services. There are offering baskets at the Info Desk for your offerings as you exit.

**Greeters will be wearing masks.** We will not shake hands, hug, or high five. Instead, we will air hug, wave, and use verbal greetings.

**We encourage you to continue giving online.** Before and after services a touch-free bucket will be available to allow you to drop your in-person offering.

**Please continue to check-in on Facebook so we can see your attendance.**

## **Entering/Exiting**

### **Entering & Exiting the Building**

When you enter the building please let our host team know how many people are in your group so they can find you the perfect spot to sit together. (Balcony will be reserved for volunteers). After service, we will dismiss you and direct you on exiting the building to ensure a quick, safe exit.

# YOUTH

## **Guidelines for Reopening Youth Services**

★ **On July 8th, we will reopen Wednesday night youth services as normal, but we will still be following the Phase 2 guidelines put in place by our Governor and the State of Arkansas.**

- According to the Arkansas Department of Health, social distancing and masks are still recommended under the Phase 2 Guidelines and anyone who has had fever or been around or in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, should stay home.
- Therefore, in accordance with the Phase 2 Guidelines of the State of Arkansas, the following guidelines will be encouraged as we move forward with having youth services in the youth room.

### ★ **Youth Room Thoroughly Sanitized**

- The youth room and chairs will be sanitized before students and leaders arrive.

### ★ **Nothing Available Until 6:00pm**

- Outside games will be available starting at 6:00pm. Service will begin at 6:30pm.

### ★ **Check Temperatures Upon Arrival**

- We will use non-contact thermometers to check & verify each student's temperature first thing upon arrival. If they have 100.4 or higher temperature, they will not be able to stay.

### ★ **Check-In After Temperature is Verified**

- After a student's temperature has been verified, they must check in before playing games or doing anything else. A leader will be assigned to registration, making sure that we have everyone in attendance on record and contact info for each student in case of emergency or in case we need to send a student home due to fever or not feeling well.
- Registration will include first and last name of student, grade, student phone number, first and last name of at least one parent/guardian, parent/guardian's phone number and email, and home address.

### ★ **Masks Will Be Available & Encouraged, but Not Mandatory**

- Leaders will offer masks as students are checking in, but masks will not be required.

### ★ **Socially Distanced Chairs**

- Chair in the youth room will be socially distanced as best as possible and we will encourage social distancing, but we will not police students if they choose not to social distance.

### ★ **Seated and Dismissed By Row**

- We will have leaders assigned to making sure students are seated and dismissed by row.

## ★ **Students Encouraged to Stay Seated**

- Once seated and service begins, students will be encouraged to stay at their seats during worship and the remainder of the service to assure social distancing.

## ★ **Monitoring/Sanitizing Bathrooms**

- We will have leaders assigned to monitor the bathrooms so that students are not going to the bathroom in groups.
- Leaders assigned to this area will also make sure bathrooms are sanitized after used.

## ★ **Service Dismissal**

- Once service is over, students will be encouraged to immediately go outside upon dismissal to assure that everyone can hangout and still social distance.

## **Reopening Plan KidMin 2020**

### **All areas**

- Nursery Ministry will be available starting Wednesday July 8th. Pre-K Ministry will be available starting Sunday July 12th. Kids Elementary church service will be opened at a later date.
- Both kids and volunteers will not be permitted in kids ministry areas with symptoms such as fever over 100.4, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, contagious or undiagnosed rash, open / uncovered wounds or sores, or have come in contact with a person tested positive with COVID-19 within the past 14 days, will not be permitted in kids ministry areas. (Must be symptom free without medication for 24 hours before returning to kids ministry areas.)
- Parents **MUST** register each child in the appropriate age group prior to each service, as there is limited spaced due to social distancing.
- Parents, family members, and non-essential volunteers will not be permitted into kids ministry areas.
- Things such as toys, books, & other non-essentials items will not be allowed into kids ministry areas.



## **Nursery & Pre-K**

- Only essential volunteers and pre-registered children are allowed into the nursery / pre-k area.
- Children will be received at the nursery / pre-k check-in desk once temperature and any symptoms have been checked and verified.
- Parents or family members will not be allowed to enter into the nursery / pre-k hallway, but mothers with upset babies may use the cry room to tend to their needs.
- The maximum amount of babies in the nursery will be 8, the maximum amount in pre-k will be 10.
- Both areas will be sanitized as needed during the service and then fully after each service.
- At the end of the service, an essential nursery / pre-k volunteer will retrieve each child when their family arrives. Parents, family members, & non-essential volunteers will need to remain in the main hallway.
- The adult who is picking up the child **MUST** have a security slip, which will be given to the parent once the child has been checked-in. If the security slip is missing, the adult will need to fill out a quick security form. (16 years & older may pick up nursery / pre-k siblings if they have the security slip.)
- Pre-K will be available only during Sunday's 10:30 AM morning service. Nursery will be available during both Sunday 10:30 AM morning services and Wednesday night services.
